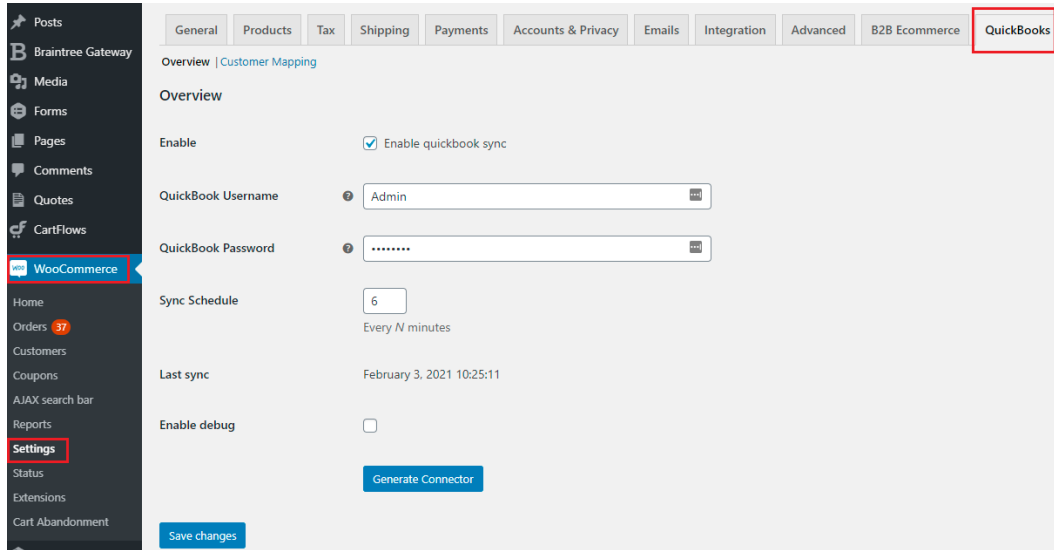
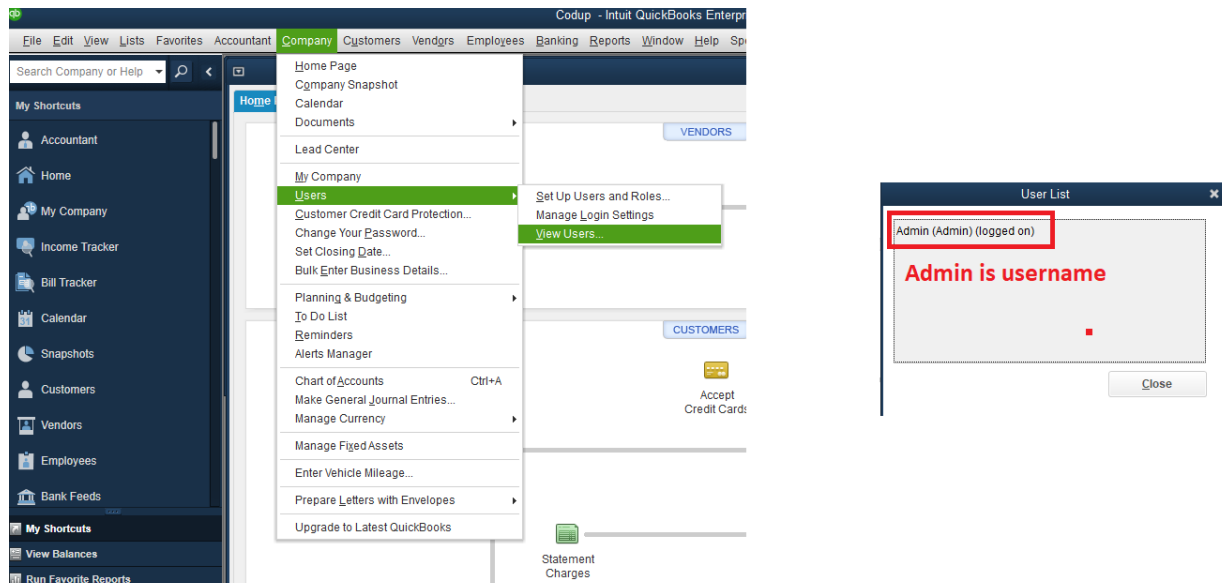


Quick Books integration with WooCommerce

- We developed a QuickBooks integration with WooCommerce. To setup this you have to install a Quickbooks in your system and our plugin on WooCommerce.
- Open QuickBooks and create a new Company.
- Then on WooCommerce go to Settings here you will find a QuickBooks Tab.



- After enabling the functionality, you need a user name & password of Quickbooks. You can easily find the Username just follow the steps as shown in below screenshot.



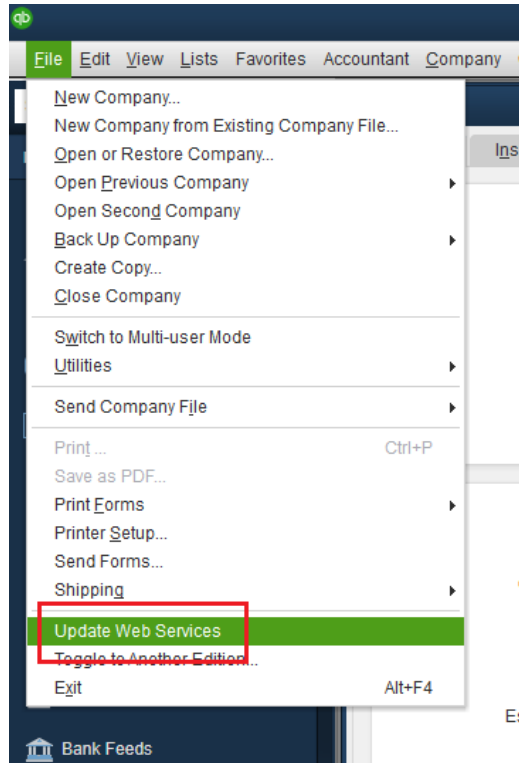
- Enter the “Username” in QuickBooks Username Field as shown in below attached screenshot. Then enter the QuickBooks Password whatever you want to enter, then we have sync schedule field enter any number here so the sync will run after that number of minutes then we have a last sync option which shows us the date and time when last sync run. After filling all the details click on save changes and In the end we have a **Generate Connector** button click on it a file will start downloading on your system.

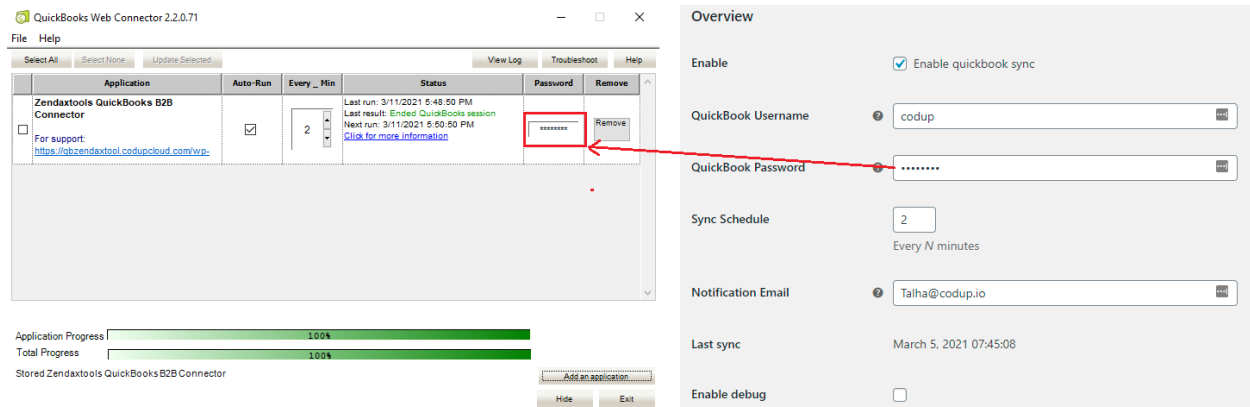
- Then open QuickBooks go to file and click on update web services.



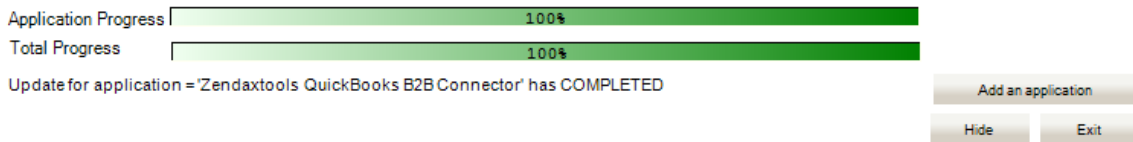
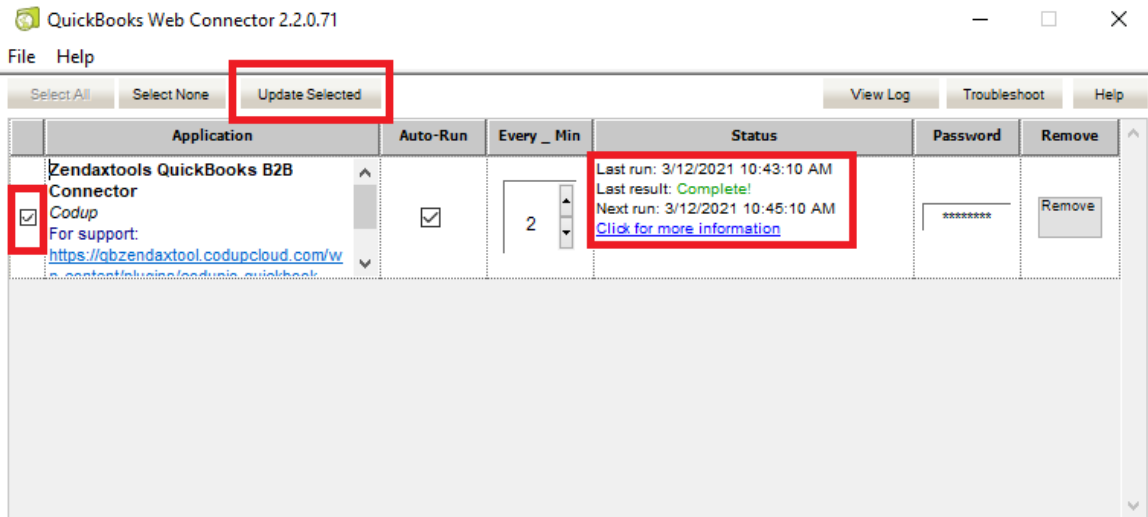
- A window like this will open now, click on Add an application and upload here a downloaded file which we download by clicking on **Generate Connector**.



- After uploading a file, a window like this will open enter the password here which we entered in WooCommerce **Quickbooks password** field as shown in below attached screenshot.

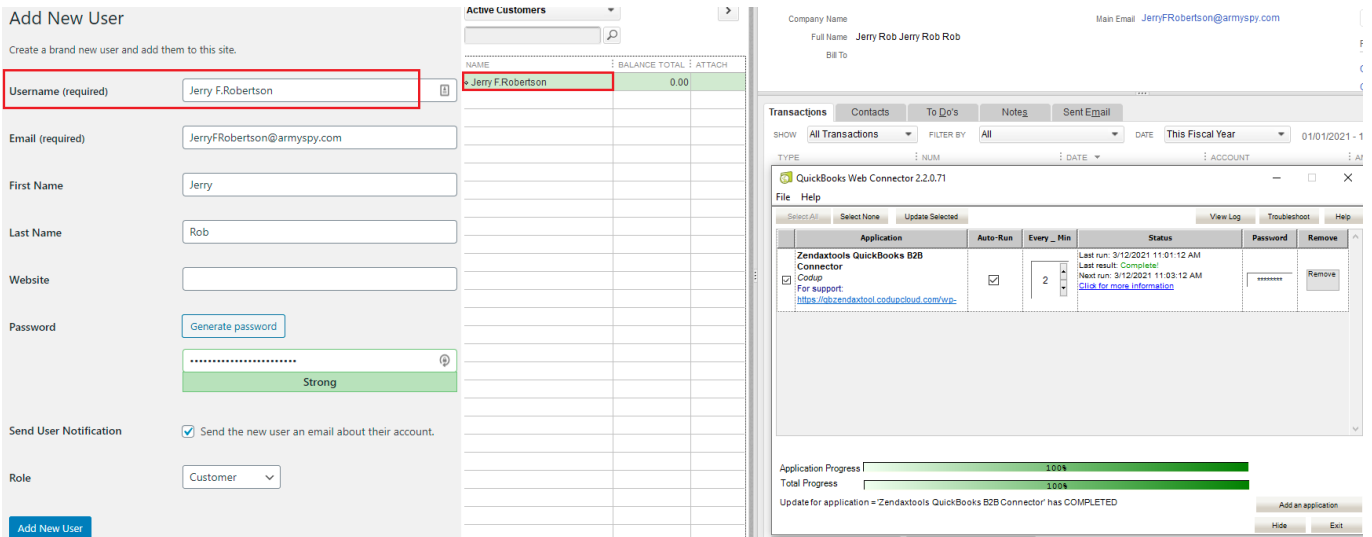


- To make sure your connection is stable or not just mark check on the checkbox and click on **Update selected** button then in the status column if last result is completed is shown that's mean your connection is perfect.



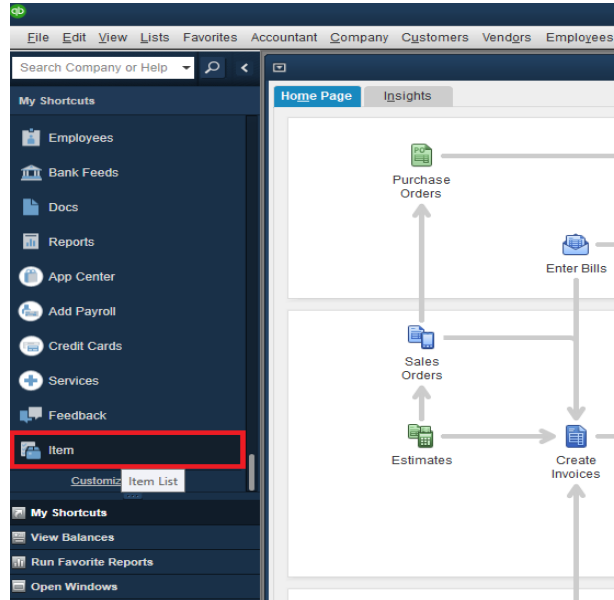
1. Create a new user:

- Now create a new user on WooCommerce as shown in screenshot and run a sync again after successful sync in a customer tab a new Customer automatically created on your Quickbooks as shown in below screenshot.

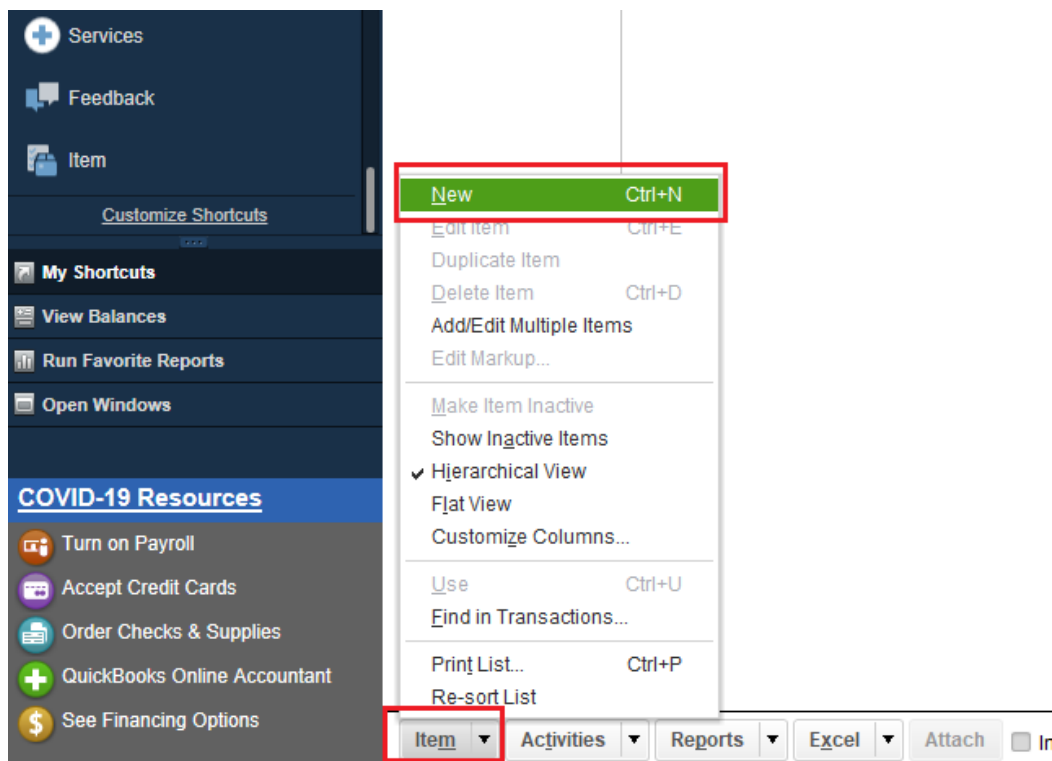


2. Sync inventory From Quickbooks To WooCommerce:

- Create an inventory on Quickbooks and after sync it will also create on WooCommerce store. To achieve this task, go to Item's menu as shown in screenshot.



- Now at the bottom of the screen you will find an **item** dropdown click on it and click on New.



Then this below attached screenshot screen will open.

- **1 > Select Type:** Inventory part
- **2 > Item Name/Number:** Enter the name of product which you want to create on WC.
- **3 > Class:** Select a class which is category on WC you can create new or sub categories by clicking on < Add New >.
- **4 > Sales Price:** Enter the price which is regular price on WC.
- **5 > On Hand:** This is stock on WooCommerce you can enter Stock qty here.
- After filling all these fields click on OK button which is shown in blue color.

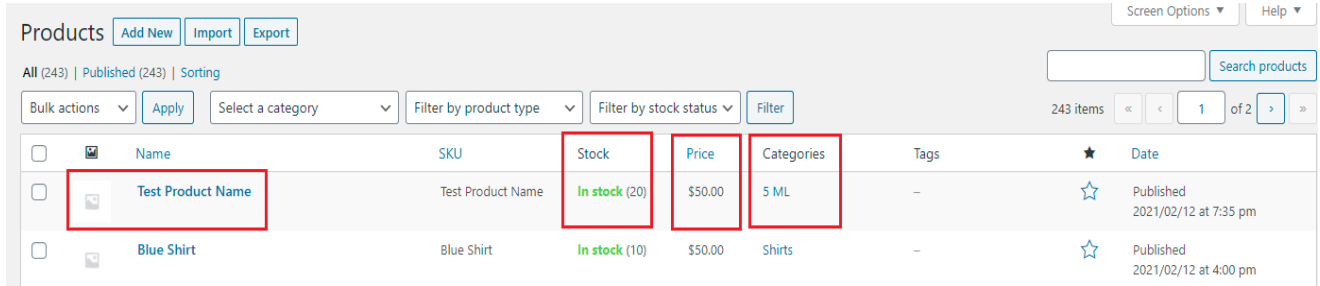

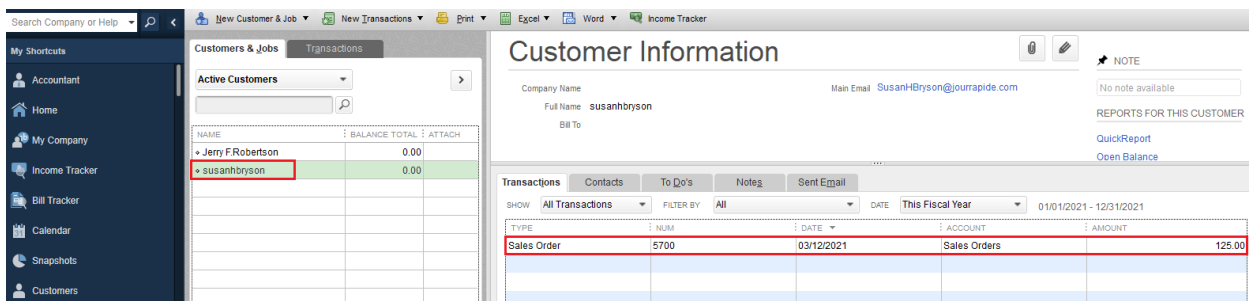
3. Sync Order from WooCommerce To Quickbooks:
